T1 Timothy	STELLAR	Regis	<p>Star heifer bull by Sitz Stellar 726D out of a cow by Coleman Regis 904. Stellar was 30kg at birth, 411kg at 205 days and 595kg at 365 days. Frame 6.2. This sire offers a top of 17% for Calving Ease Direct and a top of 11% for Daughters Calving Ease. His extremely short Gestation Length (top 4%) is confirmed in the paddock. Birth weight stands at +2.7 or top 20%. Yet this bull is able to reach a top of 6% for 400 DAYS and a top of 8% for 600 DAYS. Excellent Eye Muscle. Fat positive. Very Docile. Top footed sire scoring best 4% for both Angle and Claw. Most sought after sire in the U.S. now.</p> <p>His son "Timothy T1" can also stand his ground. He landed first as did his half sister S1 and his younger full brother U1. The Dam of Timothy is a champion in Short Gestation. P50 as she is called, delivers her calf every year ahead of the whole herd. P50 is parent verified.</p> <p>As an extra information, I will mention that her sire (Regis) comes with top 1% for both calving ease, top 10% for Gestation Length and a BWT in the top 3%.</p> <p>Timothy T1 scores a top of 8% for DIR, top of 6% for DTRS and a phenomenal Gestation Length in the top 1%. BWT is +2.1 or top 12%. T1 is one of the safest bulls we have produced.</p> <p>Good growth here especially for 400 days. Good eye muscle. Splendid fat cover (rib top 9%, P8: top 20%).</p>
T2 Tobias	STELLAR	Complement	<p>Star heifer bull by Stellar out of a cow by EF Complement 8088: "The Pines Eva N69". A strong dam. Lots of calving ease here (+6.9/+7.) coupled with a very low birth weight (+2.5). N69 landed at 34 kg (like her Dam). In other words: a safe history for calving.</p> <p>The sire of the Dam (Complement) is also extremely safe. His calving ease direct (DIR: top 19%) and his calving ease future daughters (DTRS: top 1%) ample growth (+130 for 600 DAYS), eye muscle (+8.2 or top 17%). Fat positive. Docile.</p> <p>The combination Stellar son out of a complement daughter - or "Tobias T2" - offers: calving ease direct +6.8 (top 17%), calving ease future daughters +7.5 (top 8%) and a strikingly short gestation length of -10.3 (top 2%). Maybe I should inform you that N69 calved this year, just after P50. Eva N69 had "U2". Tobias has a younger full sister.</p> <p>T2 has more growth than T1. Will serve his herd promptly. Good eye muscle. Fat positive (top 9% Rib, top 11% for P8).</p>

COMMAND 338

Star heifer bull by Baldridge Command C036 out of a cow by Hyline Right Time 338. A word about the sire: Command was 31kg at birth, 378kg at 205 days and 660kg at 365 days. Frame: 6. Strong bull with high growth 61/105/136 or top 5%, 7% and 10% for respectively 200, 400 and 600 DAYS. Carcass +7.4 or top 18%. Eye muscle soars in the top 1% (+12.5). Command is also a milky bull (+22 or top 11%) and he is a sensational calving ease sire with a score of top 3% for DIRECT calving ease and top 4% for future DAUGHTERS. Gestation is short (top 9%). Birthweight is moderate: +2.5 only or top 14%. Fat negative. Very docile. Good footed (top 13% angle, top 23% claw). In terms of fertility: we used sexed semen this year and the results were excellent.

"Tommy T7" resembles his sire. He offers very good calving ease (+7.5 and +6.7 or top 12% and 13%). He landed early: 10 days ahead of the date due. The EBV give him a figure of -7.4 for Gestation Length or top 13%. Birthweight is +2.7 or top 13%. He too is a milky bull (+20 or top 29%) equipped with good eye muscle (+8.4 or top 17%).

Tommy's Dam is one of the matrons. This daughter of 338 has a wide top line with an eye muscle of +5.4 when the average of her contemporaries was +4.2. Lots of milk. High fertility. This cow: "The Pines Elsa H35" is also the Dam of one of our best bulls "Nelligam N64". Extra information: H35 was 32.5kg at birth. Footscored top 4% for angle, top 33% for claw. The EBV give her excellent figures in calving ease and low birthweight. H35 is P.V.

Straws by the Sire of the Dam (338) are difficult to find. Have a look at this combination (Command / 338) if your herd needs different bloodlines.

Talbot

COMMAND Reserve

Maternal star heifer bull by Command out of a cow by VAR Reserve 1111. "Talbot T11" had a great look from DAY 1 and he scored the top weight on his weaning day among 19 bull calves.

What gives Talbot his Maternal definition? The presence of Sitz Traveler 8180 on his Dam line, is your answer. This Maternal Sire produced D10, maternal grand Dam of Talbot. Born quite light (30kg), D10 grew into a tall female. Her daughter by VAR Reserve 1111 is L74. Also moderate in her birthweight: 36kg. Yet L74 evolved into a tall and heavy matron. The Sire of the Dam (Reserve) is known for his excellent calving ease, low birthweight and high eye muscle. Born 35kg. Weaning 322kg. Yearling 539kg. Mature Weight of 1035kg. Frame 6. Scrotal 12 months: 40 cm.

"Talbot T11" landed 11 days ahead of the date due and the EBV give him a figure of -7. or top 16% for his short gestation length. Birthweight stands at a top of 25% (+3.) while calving ease DIRECT reaches a top of 7% (or +8.6). T11 is a milky bull. He has plenty of Eye muscle and he is very docile. Retail Beef Yield: top 6%.

T12
Titus

COMMAND All In

Maternal bull, heifer bull and growth bull. "Titus T12" has it all! He is a fantastic curve bender. Sired by Command out of a daughter by Deer Valley All In. Scores the n^o1 index result in his mob: \$239 for \$F1 or top 11% and \$346 for A-L or top 22%.

T12 offers a low birthweight: +2.9 or top 23%. His calving ease are very good around the top 27%. Gestation is short: top 14%. Extra information: his dam (M103) was 38 kg at birth, the sire of his dam (All In) was 31 kg, the maternal grand dam of Titus was 33 kg. Safe history.

This grand dam (The Pines Delia E7) is the key component of the Maternal aspect in T12. She is a daughter of GDAR Traveler 71. NO more straws can be found from this Maternal Sire. Consider this type of pedigree as rare.

The growth curve of T12 reaches +54/+96/+123 for 200, 400 and 600 DAYS (or top 25%/top 29%/top 33%). Eye muscle: +8.3 (top 18%). Carcass +68. T12 will sire heavy progeny as he is the direct result of a mix by Command (600 DAYS: +136) and All In (600 DAYS: +128).

T16
Tasman

COMMAND Thunderbird

Star heifer bull and high growth bull. "Tasman T16" is also a curve bender. This son of Command has a Dam, daughter of SAV Thunderbird 9061.

If we look at his figures: T16 offers a very low birthweight (+2.7 or top 20%), his calving ease DIRECT is +7.6 (top 12%) and his gestation is short (-7.2 or top 14%). In other words: Tasman T16 is a perfect heifer bull. T16 landed 9 days ahead of the date due.

According to our records, his dam (M20) was only 34 kg at birth. Maternal grand dam by Bando 9074 was 32.5 kg. This cow (The Pines Rita Firefly J7) is still with us. At the age of 10 years, J7 is one of the best looking females in the herd.

In terms of growth, T16 is a "rocket". Scores 56/99/125 for 200, 400 and 600 DAYS (or top 18% 22% and 31%). Carcass: +69. Excellent indexes: top 16% for \$F1 and top 19% for \$F1-L.

This growth curve can be explained. T16 is a son by Command (high growth sire) out of a Damline produced by Thunderbird (high growth sire with +130 and top 1% in 2015), Bando 9074 (quite massive but with low BWT) and Papa Equator 2928 (one of the biggest growth bulls of the breed).

Doyle, fat negative, milky bull. Top 8% for Retail Beef Yield.

Consider this type of curve bender if your herd will benefit from the power and the variety of T16's maternal bloodlines. Extra information: there are no more straws of Papa Equator 2928. This fact gives Tasman T16 an exclusive edge.

T18
Tintoretto

STELLAR Complement

Combined heifer bull and high growth bull. T18 offers great calving ease and he scores the highest growth in his mob (+128 for 600 DAYS). T18 is therefore a star curve bender.

T18 is a son of Sitz Stellar out of a cow by Complement (P87).

The dam of T18 merits a mention. The lines "A League" A top performer. Calved "Ug" a full sister of T18, a few weeks ago. Mangoux P87 comes to the party with generous calving ease, low birthweight, good growth (+118 for 600 DAYS when the average was +112), carcass +67, EMA+5.7 and fine tuned fat cover.

Henson (T18) inherits from his dam a long list of world sires: Complement, Thunderbird, Future Direction and Design 208.

Named after a great painter from Venice, Tintoretto is the type of bull which will add a handsome shape to your herd. He offers a superb fat cover (top 10% for RB and top 18% for PB). Good Miek. Good Carcass (+69). Monks: top 21% and 15%. Very prompt to serve.

T21
Tiepolo

STELLAR Thunderbird

Heifer bull and high growth bull with a maternal background. T21 is a son by Stellar out of a daughter by Thunderbird.

Maternal bloodline unites Thunderbird Sitz Upward, Leachman Right Time 2700 and Rito 2100 GDAR. The succession of these sires accounts for the maternal aspect of T21. Named after another famous painter from Venice, "Tiepolo T21" will sire good looking daughters.

He is also a safe bull with short gestation and low birthweight (top 23%). Growthgrid is impressive: 55/102/127 for 200, 400 and 600 DAYS. We are looking here at a curve bender scoring a top of 25%, 14% and 26% in respective growth classification. Notice that he is an ideal bull for the 400 DAY market. Indexes rank him: top 23% \$A, top 21% \$A-L.

The Damline is called: the "Eva line". No shortage of heavy matrons here yet born with a moderate birthweight. The heifer Eva M7 (dam of T21) landed at 32kg. Her dam (J23) was 33kg. And her dam (E98) was only 34kg at birth. A safe history.

Extra information: M7 had +66 in Carcass (average of her contemporaries being +56). Maternal grand dam of Tiepolo (J23) scores +63 (average was then +53). A long history of carcass cows. Sire of the Dam (Thunderbird) has +70 in CW while sire of the Maternal Grand Dam (Sitz Upward) has +82 for this trait.

This history is confirmed by our DNA results. M7, J23, E98 and C55 are Parent Verified.

T22
Titian

PATRIARCH Birthstone

New American sire here! Titian T22 is a son by Tehama Patriarch F028 out of a cow by SAV Birthstone 8258. T22 is a heifer bull and an Allrounder.

Patriarch was only 28 kg at birth. He reached 268 kg at 205 DAYS, 510 kg at 365 DAYS. At 33 months he weighed 832 kg. Scrotal size at 27 months: 40 cm. Patriarch was a record setter from the Tehama program in autumn 2018. Tehama Angus Ranch is an old and a famous stud in California, highly specialized in Maternal pedigrees.

If we peruse the figures, Patriarch scores +11.3 (or top 2%) in calving ease DIRECT while his calving ease for future daughters is +9. (or top 5%). Gestation is short (top 11%) and we can confirm that his calves land early. Growth curve is amazing: 62/115/141 or top 4%, 9% and 6% for respective 200, 400 and 600 DAYS.

Birthweight is very low: +1.2 or top 4%. Patriarch is a curve bender blessed with high fertility, good milk and top eye muscle of +9.1 or top 11%.

The DAM of T22 is a big cow. Her dam is a daughter of Papa Equator 2928. There is a lot of eye muscle in this background. T22's dam CM111 has +7.3 in EMA (the average of her contemporaries being +4.2). According to his figures, Titian T22 inherits the excellent EMA of both his Dam and his Sire.

This bull should appeal to breeders looking for a safe muscular Allrounder. Indexes: top 29% and 30%. Extra information: Titian T22 has a younger full sister: U17.

T24

COMMAND Thunderbird

Heifer bull, growth bull and Allrounder by Command out of a cow by Thunderbird. Compare T24 and T16. They share the same genetic pattern.

In both cases, birthweight is very low: here +2.8 (or top 22%); T16 offering +2.7 (or top 20%). Short gestation defines the two bulls. Good growth, good carcass and excellent eye muscle appear in the two EBV.

For those who want to know about the make up of a pedigree, I can say that Bando 9074 is present in T16's background and that Bando 598 appears in T24's genealogy.

Let's zoom in on the Dam of Trevor T24. The Pines Elsa M73 is a strong daughter by Thunderbird. She has good calving ease DIRECT, a short gestation, a good stretch from low birthweight (landed at 35 kg) to 600 days growth of +107 (average being +95). Her carcass is +60 (average is +52). The maternal grand dam of T24 (E136) was also light at birth: 33 kg. She evolved into a female with great capacity. Had +51 in carcass when the average was +42. Also: scored +32 in DIRECT calving ease compared to an average of -0.6 for her contemporaries. T24: Safe curve bender to produce heavy progeny.

T25
Tangvy

STELLAR Rampage

Heifer bull, growth bull and Allrounder, T25 offers many types of uses. If your herd needs only one bull, then you should consider this one.

Sired by the most wanted Sire in the U.S. (STELLAR), Tangvy T25 has a lot going for him. Don't forget that Stellar is a high calving ease bull with hermendorously low gestation, moderate birthweight followed by a steep growth curve.

The Sire of the Dam (P85) mounts a presentation. Quaker Hill Rampage OA36 is an extremely high growth bull scoring 65/107/139 for 200, 400 and 600 DAYS or tops 2%, 5%, 7%. His Carcass of +77 ranks firm in the top 13% while eye muscle scores at +126 or top 1%.

A mix Stellar/Rampage is safe. It comes with a low birth weight (+3.5 or top 35%), short gestation (-6. or top 98%), good growth produced by two growth bulls, not to mention a Carcass of +67 and an EMF of +7.9 (or top 22%). "Tangvy T25" has a perfect fat cover and Retail Beef Yield in the top 16%. He will serve his herd promptly (DC -59 or top 27%).

Index results: \$221 or top 24% for \$A and \$376 or top 22% for \$A-L.

T26
Travis

COMMAND Birthstone

Milky heifer bull with an Eye muscle of +9.4 or top 10%. Given his very high Calving Ease Direct figure of +7.6 (or top 12%), we could rank him, in fact, as a Star heifer bull.

Travis T26 is a son by Command out of a cow by SAV Birthstone 8258.

Before I comment on the figures, I wish to make you aware that T26 has a "Maternal" Damline: his Dam (M8) is - as mentioned - mired by Birthstone. His maternal grand dam (K16) is sired by Sitz Upward and his maternal great grand dam (C69) was sired by Leachman Right Time 2700. This type of pedigree qualifies T26 as a Maternal bull, i.e. able to sire good looking daughters.

We have used Birthstone extensively in our program regarding heifers. Great calving eases, low BWT (+0.9 only) and short gestation make him a reliable option.

As a mix from Command/Birthstone, "Travis T26" presents many interesting traits: he landed 6 days before the date due (gestation is -5.3), BWT reaches a top of 22% (or +9.8), Carcass stands at +65, fat negative with a Retail Beef Yield in the top 4%.

Indexes are good: \$A at \$224 or top 21% and \$A-L at \$360 or top 33%.

T30
Turner

COMMAND

J20
son by 338

Safe Allrounder with good growth, good carcass (+66) and excellent eye muscle (+8. or top 21%). Retail Beef yield: top 8%. Index: top 24% in \$A or \$221.

Turner T30 is a son by Command out of N18, a strong cow daughter of J20 N18 was 37kg at birth. Her dam (K15), daughter of Thunderbolt, was 42.5kg. Her dam (E3), daughter of Tapa Equator 2928, was 36kg at birth.

J20 needs a presentation. A son of 338 out of a cow by GDFR Traveler 71, he landed at 40.5kg. Elegant bull calf. Left his mark on the herd with superb daughter.

To sum up: Turner T30 is also a Maternal Bull. He will sire handsome progeny. His daughters will have good milk.

A son by Command backed by a dam line including Hyline Right Time 338, GDFR Traveler 71, Thunderbolt and Tapa Equator 2928 is rare. Check out this bull if replacement females are on your agenda.

STELLAR

J21
son by
Sitz Upward

Allrounder with carcass, good eye muscle and an excellent fat positive trait. Among his many qualities, I will point out that Terry T31 has a short gestation. He landed 5 days ahead of the date due. The EBV give him -5.6 or top 33%. Another valuable feature: he will be prompt in serving his herd. Scores -5.9 in Days to Calve or top 27%.

Index rank him: \$A top 33% or \$212 and \$A-L top 34% or \$359.

The sire of the Dam: James J21 is a son by Sitz Upward out of a cow by Leachman Right Time 2700 (C69).

J21 landed at 42.5kg. A big and beautiful bull calf. Produced strong daughters (still with us). J21 scored +65 in Carcass (average being +53) and +8.6 in EMA (when the average was +4.3).

Given the presence of Maternal sire in his Dam line, T31 qualifies as a Maternal Bull. USA 598, USA 2700 and Sitz Upward will generate a good shape for any herd.

Take Terry T31 if a Maternal son by Stellar fits your program. Compare T31 and T21.

T32
Troy

COMPLEMENT Dead Center

New genetic combination here! T32 is a son by EF Complement 8088 out of a cow by Quaker Hill Dead Center (PZ). Complement is widely used. Has 5224 progeny (mar. 2021). He was 35 kg at birth, 301 kg for 205 days and 563 kg for 365 days. Frame 6. A true Curve Gender with great calving ease, low BWT and very high growth. CW top 13%. EMA: top 11%.

The Sire of the Dam (Dead Center) offers also excellent calving ease, low BWT, high growth, carcass and eye muscle. He was 33 kg at birth, 354 kg at weaning, and 647 kg as a yearling. Frame 6. This sire scores top 1% for 200 and 400 DAYS. His son in our program (NG5) had a mature weight of 4106 kg.

In other words: a mix Complement/Dead center will yield heavy muscular progeny. Extra information: there is Papa Equator 2928, Future Direction and Design 208 in the pedigree. Many layers of world known sires lead up to "Troy T32".

Let us sum up: T32 is a heifer bull, a very safe Allrounder. Carcass is good. Eye muscle scores top 27%. T32 is also a milky and fat positive bull.

Only 2 sons by Complement sell: T32 and T38. Compare both.

T33

PATRIARCH Vermilion
Dateline

To those who are chasing alternative bloodlines, I propose a high Carcass bull by Tehanna Patriarch out of a cow by Vermilion Dateline 7078: Tristan T33

The sire of the Dam (USA 7078) is an extremely high growth sire with a short gestation. His daughters, in our program, look great and respond well to AI. K51 (dam of T33) is one of these. K51 landed at a solid 42 kg. Scores +100 for 600 DAYS (when the average of her contemporaries was +91); reached +63 in carcass (average being +49) and excelled in eye muscle with +7.9 (when the average was +3.9).

Tristan T33 is a Growth bull with top eye muscle (+8.7, or 15% best). Retail Beef yield scores a top of 3% while Net Feed Intake stands at top 9%. He is particularly suited for the 400 Day market (top 25%).

Bull to be used over fat positive mature cows. The Patriarch/Vermilion Dateline mix has a Maternal touch. It will give power and elegance to any herd.

T35
Trajam

PATRIARCH

J21
son by
Sitz Upward

Highly Maternal bull. Also a powerful Growth bull named after Emperor Trajam. Extra kids and a good shape will come with this combination. Trajam T35 is a son by Tehama Patriarch out of a big cow (N28) by J21.

As stated previously, J21 was a son by Sitz Upward out of a daughter of Leachman Right Time 2700. Muscular. Good looking. He sired 60 progeny here.

As the weights on the Dam line were quite heavy (N28 landed at 45 kg; her dam hit the ground at 40 kg), we used the light birth weight of Patriarch to produce a more operational bull calf.

T35 offers +3 in Calving Ease DIRECT and +2.2 in Calving Ease future DAUGHTERS. T35 is a bull which has safe calving. His growth is spectacular: 54/98/195 or top 26%, 24% and 29% for respectively 200, 400 and 600 DAYS. Carcass +69. EMF +6.1. Ideal fat cover. Indexes: \$A: 219 or top 26%; \$A-L: 361 or top 32%.

In terms of classification: T35 is a Maternal Bull, an Flounder with safe calving ease and a Growth bull. According to the EBV: most fertile in his mob.

Should a new sire be on your agenda, sons by Tehama Patriarch may fit your breeding program. In that case, compare T35, T33 and T22. Only 3 "Patriarchs" are for sale during this season.

T36
Theo

STELLAR Black Pearl

Theo T36 is a son by Stellar out of a cow by Sydgun Black Pearl (P46). Maternal grand dam (C62) was our best looking daughter of Leachman Right Time 2700.

This type of mix reveals a Maternal bull. T36 will sire beautiful daughters.

The Sire of the Dam (Black Pearl) merits a mention. Born 39 kg. Was 338 kg at 205 DAYS, 610 kg at 365 DAYS. Mature weight 1152 kg. Frame 6.5. Mat. Scrotal: 41.5 cm.

Remember that the Sire (Stellar) has a frame of 6.2. Should you plan to raise the overall frame of your herd, this combination could be relevant.

T36 is a big, quiet Growth bull with a top of 28% for 400 DAYS and 34% for 600 DAYS. Good CW. Good EMF +6.1. Superb fat positive (top 6%/top 15%). Will serve his herd promptly (he is in the top 30%).

T38
Toby

COMPLEMENT Sitz Upward

Upward in his mob but not lightest!
Toby T38 was 2nd heaviest bull calf
at weaning.

T38 is a son by Complement out
of a cow by Sitz Upward 307 R.
Complement has a growth curve of
53/98/130 for 280, 400 and 600 DAYS.
Sitz Upward's growth stands at 60/
107/128 for the same traits.
Carcases of Complement: +75 while
carcases of Sitz Upward is +82.

From these two sires, T38,
inherits good growth especially for
400 DAYS a carcass of +70, EMA+6.5,
lots of milk (+23 on top 11%) and
a perfect fat cover (+0.6/+0.4).

Tedigree shows that Maternal
Grand dam (D8) is a daughter by
Sitz Traveler 8180. As you can
see, there is a strong influence from
the Sitz Tranch in Montana. I think
this is a plus given their emphasis
on high quality females. D8 was
one of the best performing 8180 females
in her flush.

In brief: "Toby T38" is a
Maternal Bull and a Growth Bull.
He will sire heavy, handsome progeny.

If a Complement son suits your
breeding program, compare the
two proposals on offer here: T38
(Complement / Sitz Upward) and T32
(Complement / Dead Center).
